

MOUNTAIN ARTS ON BROADWAY POLICIES

Mountain Arts on Broadway is a project
of the Manzano Mountain Art Council

Mission Statement: Mountain Arts on Broadway, (MAOB), a community art center, is established to provide work space for community programs (such as mural/mosaic projects); art classes, workshops for adults and children; public space for presentation of art forms such as dance, music, theater, the written word, etc.; studio space for artists to rent; and space to showcase local, and regional, and national artists' work.

MAOB Committee: The committee will consist of a Manzano Mountain Art Council (MMAC) board member, a MAOB resident artist, and members of the community. The committee will meet once a month to evaluate issues, needs, and policies of MAOB. The committee will be limited to no more than five members. Meetings are open to the public. Committee duties will be developed by the committee. The committee will present recommendations for substantive action or expenditure of funds to the MMAC board for approval before initiating action or expenditure.

MAOB Committee Director: The MMAC board will appoint a board member to serve as director of MAOB and as a direct liaison between MAOB and the MMAC board. All rentals, workshops, meetings and fee payments must be done through the director. The director is responsible for overseeing the meeting agenda, minutes, calendar, and an event budget tracking system to reconcile MAOB events with appropriate payments.

Studio Space: Artists who rent studio space at MAOB are required to sign a minimum six (6) month rental agreement. The current rental rate is \$50 per 100 square feet of studio space. Utilities are included; however, tenants may be requested to pay a small pro-rated surcharge in months when heat and electricity are excessive. In addition, there will be a charge of \$10 per firing of a large kiln and \$5 for a small kiln.

Workshops, Classes, Performances: Space at MAOB is available for rent for workshops/on-going classes, meetings, and public performances at the rate of \$5 per hour for use of the building and an additional setup/takedown charge of \$15.00. There is no charge if you are providing the event for free or if you are doing the set up/take down yourself. MMAC members who have non-charge discussion groups or gatherings need not pay for the space but must be willing to let MMAC or MAOB-sponsored events have priority. Donations to MMAC and MAOB are welcome and encouraged. All presenters are asked to complete the Presenter Form located on the MMAC website, Art Center page, or in racks at the art center. Publicity for events, including your information on the Presenter Form, will be sent to MMAC email distribution lists, web sites, Facebook and Mountainair Announcements Blog. All publicity for events at MAOB must include that MAOB is sponsored by Manzano Mountain Art Council.

Subject to Change: Rates for studio space and workshop/class space may be adjusted in the future upon timely and appropriate notice to resident artists and presenters. MMAC reserves the right to accept or deny presentations.
